A September Pondering from Pam

The teacher, parent and grandmother in me sees September as a time for new beginnings. This September it is also an opportunity to renew our church offering of the chalice at Holy Communion.

All 3 churches will return to the practice of everyone being offered intincted wafers and then the opportunity to receive from a chalice away from the central distribution.

This arrangement is obviously optional. Not everyone wants to share the common cup, especially as recent events have highlighted Covid's activity.

For such an arrangement to be possible we need to enlarge the ministry team for distribution of bread and wine. It is a long time since we had chalice ministers. Offering the chalice is a ministry, a service not a job. Such responsibility requires training and understanding of the whole sacramental aspects of worship.

Rev Sarah will be arranging preparation for all who will be involved. Previous experience is not required, nor is it an entitlement to continue. Within church discipline, all ordained ministers have to continue with reviews and training [My next course starts in September]. We are not asking or expecting anything that we clergy are not prepared to do ourselves.

It will be our delight to increase the ministry team for Holy Communion, because 'team' is at the core of being church.

As a benefice, we have shared wonderful examples of teams in action – from our musicians we have had choral support regardless of which church was involved, to the impromptu need to cover for an organist and choral teacher at very short notice – life and Covid happen. We have seen money raised for church and charity by mega teamwork, many hands have made a significant impact on the loved looks of our 3 buildings, new leaders are emerging to form lay ministers and new voices are joining the teams of readers and intercessors.

We are indebted to the contributions being made with love and generosity – those involved all had to do it for the first time at some point. We hope to encourage more participation. We commit to train, prepare and support anyone who is drawn to a fuller, or different, involvement in the life of the Benefice.

Does this nudge you?

If so, talk to one of us clergy and you talk to the team. We are here to enable and support whatever renewal September brings.

May grace fill your days wherever they are spent.
